Dear Family:

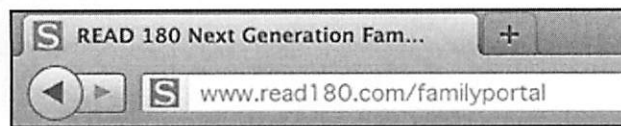

Here's what you can do when you visit the *READ 180* Family Portal:

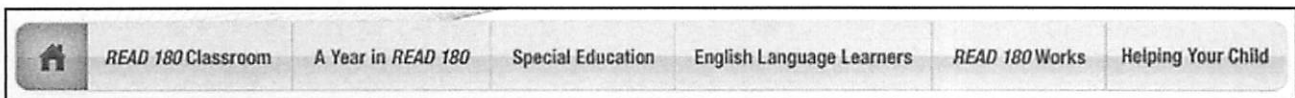
- Learn how *READ 180* works so you can understand what happens in the classroom.
